2. Heart, Soul, and Body.


Mark 12:30 NLT

'And you must love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, all your mind, and all your strength.'


3. Entering His Presence.

- ³ Acknowledge that the Lord is God! He made us, and we are his. We are his people, the sheep of his pasture.




- 4. Praise and Power

 - "Give thanks to the Lord; his faithful love endures forever!"




5. More than a song.

John 14:16-18 ESV



¹⁸ "I will not leave you as orphans; I will come to you".


2. His **omnipresence**


Psalms 139:7-12a NLT
