


3 YOU AND YOUR FIGHTING MEN SHOULD MARCH AROUND THE TOWN ONCE A DAY FOR SIX DAYS. 4 SEVEN PRIESTS WILL WALK AHEAD OF THE ARK, EACH CARRYING A RAM'S HORN. ON THE SEVENTH DAY YOU ARE TO MARCH AROUND THE TOWN SEVEN TIMES, WITH THE PRIESTS BLOWING THE HORNS.

JOSHUA 6:3-4 NLT




AFTER JOSHUA SPOKE TO THE PEOPLE, THE SEVEN PRIESTS WITH THE RAMS' HORN STARTED MARCHING IN THE PRESENCE OF THE LORD, BLOWING THE HORNS AS THEY MARCHED. AND THE ARK OF THE LORD'S COVENANT FOLLOWED BEHIND THEM.

JOSHUA 6:8 NLT



<sup>9</sup> Some of the armed men marched in front of the priests with the horns and some behind the Ark, with the priests continually blowing the horns. <sup>10</sup> "Do not shout; do not even talk," Joshua commanded. "Not a single word from any of you until I tell you to shout. Then shout!"



<sup>11</sup> So the Ark of the Lord was carried around the town once that day, and then everyone returned to spend the night in the camp.

14 ON THE SECOND DAY THEY AGAIN MARCHED AROUND THE TOWN ONCE AND RETURNED TO THE CAMP. THEY FOLLOWED THIS PATTERN FOR SIX DAYS. JOSHUA 6:11, 14 NLT <sup>15</sup> On the seventh day the Israelites got up at dawn and marched around the town as they had done before. But this time they went around the

20 WHEN THE PEOPLE HEARD THE SOUND OF THE RAMS' HORNS, THEY SHOUTED AS LOUD AS THEY COULD. SUDDENLY, THE WALLS OF JERICHO COLLAPSED, AND THE ISRAELITES CHARGED STRAIGHT INTO THE TOWN AND CAPTURED IT. **JOSHUA 6:20 NLT**

### THE ISRAELITES DISPLAYED FAITH:

JOSHUA AND ISRAEL BELIEVED THE BATTLE PLAN.



## The Israelites displayed <u>faith</u>: Joshua and Israel <u>believed</u> the battle plan.

<sup>3</sup>YOU AND YOUR FIGHTING MEN SHOULD MARCH AROUND THE TOWN ONCE A DAY FOR SIX DAYS. <sup>4</sup> SEVEN PRIESTS

WILL WALK AHEAD OF THE ÅRK, EACH CARRYING A RAM'S HORN. ON THE SEVENTH DAY YOU ARE TO MARCH AROUND THE TOWN SEVEN TIMES, WITH THE PRIEST BLOWING THE HORNS.

## THE ISRAELITES DISPLAYED FAITH: JOSHUA AND ISRAEL BELIEVED THE BATTLE PLAN.

5 When you hear the priests give one long blast

ON THE RAMS' HORNS, HAVE ALL THE PEOPLE SHOUT AS LOUD AS THEY CAN. THEN THE WALLS OF THE TOWN WILL COLLAPSE, AND THE PEOPLE CAN CHARGE STRAIGHT INTO THE TOWN."



IT REQUIRED GREAT FAITH FROM JOSHUA, BECAUSE HE HAD TO EXPLAIN AND LEAD THE NATION IN THIS PLAN. IT ALSO REQUIRED GREAT FAITH FROM THE ELDERS AND THE NATION, BECAUSE THEY HAD TO FOLLOW JOSHUA IN THIS PLAN.



### THE ISRAELITES DISPLAYED OBEDIENCE:



## THE ISRAELITES DISPLAYED <u>OBEDIENCE</u>: JOSHUA AND ISRAEL <u>FOLLOWED</u> THE BATTLE PLAN EXACTLY.

8 AFTER JOSHUA SPOKE TO THE PEOPLE, THE SEVEN PRIESTS WITH THE RAMS' HORNS STARTED MARCHING IN THE PRESENCE OF THE LORD, BLOWING THE HORNS AS THEY MARCHED. AND THE ARK OF THE LORD'S COVENANT FOLLOWED BEHIND THEM. 9 SOME OF THE ARMED MEN MARCHED IN FRONT OF THE PRIESTS WITH THE HORNS AND SOME BEHIND THE ARK, WITH THE PRIESTS CONTINUALLY BLOWING THE HORNS.

#### THE ISRAELITES DISPLAYED COURAGE:

ISRAEL FOLLOWED THE BATTLE PLAN DESPITE DANGER.

<sup>6</sup> So Joshua called together the priests and said, "Take up the Ark of the Lord's Covenant, and assign seven priests to walk in front of it, each carrying a ram's horn."

ISRAEL FOLLOWED THE BATTLE PLAN DESPITE DANGER.

<sup>7</sup>Then he gave orders to the people: "March around the town, and the armed men will lead the way in front of the Ark of the Lord."

ISRAEL FOLLOWED THE BATTLE PLAN DESPITE DANGER.

<sup>6</sup> "Be strong and courageous, for you are the one who will lead these people to possess all the land I swore to their ancestors I would give them. <sup>7</sup> Be strong and very courageous.

<sup>9</sup>This is my command—be strong and courageous! Do not be afraid or discouraged. For the Lord your God is with you wherever you go."

THE ISRAELITES DISPLAYED ENDURANCE:

ISRAEL FOLLOWED THE BATTLE PLAN OVER A PERIOD OF TIME,

EVEN WHEN IT SEEMED THAT NOTHING WAS HAPPENING.

On the second day they again marched around the town once and returned to the camp. They followed this pattern for six days. <sup>15</sup> On the seventh day the Israelites got up at dawn and marched around the town as they had done before. But this time they went around the town seven times.


THE ISRAELITES DISPLAYED ENDURANCE:

ISRAEL FOLLOWED THE BATTLE PLAN OVER A PERIOD OF TIME,

EVEN WHEN IT SEEMED THAT NOTHING WAS HAPPENING.

10 "Do not shout; do not even talk," Joshua commanded.
"Not a single word from any of you until I tell you to shout. Then shout!"

It is much harder to have the endurance God requires of us when there is no <u>shout</u>.



#### THE ISRAELITES DISPLAYED TRUST:

ISRAEL DID NOT RELY ON MILITARY SCHEMING AND WORLDLY METHODS; THEIR TRUST WAS IN THE LORD, NOT IN HUMAN INGENUITY.



# The Israelites displayed <u>trust</u>: Israel did not <u>rely</u> on military scheming and worldly methods; their trust was in the <u>Lord</u>, not in human ingenuity.

15 ON THE SEVENTH DAY THE ISRAELITES GOT UP AT DAWN AND MARCHED AROUND THE TOWN AS THEY HAD DONE BEFORE. BUT THIS TIME THEY WENT AROUND THE TOWN SEVEN TIMES. 16 THE SEVENTH TIME AROUND, AS THE PRIESTS SOUNDED THE LONG BLAST ON THEIR HORNS, JOSHUA COMMANDED THE PEOPLE, "SHOUT! FOR THE LORD HAS GIVEN YOU THE TOWN!"
