The Greek word for joy in this passage is the word <u>chara</u>. It means to have a strong inner sense of gladness or cheerfulness that is not based on circumstances.





This type of joy only comes from <a href="God">God</a>. From <a href="His">His</a> grace, love, promises and the sureness and nearness of His presence.
