


# → LEARN TO ROLL WITH THE PUNCHES

The rope-a-dope is a boxing fighting technique in which one contender eans against the ropes of the boxing ring and draws non-injuring offensive punches, letting the opponent tire themselves out. This gives the former the opportunity then to execute devastating offensive punches to help them win.
