## AMOS 7:14-15 NLT


14 But Amos replied, "I'm not a professional prophet, and I was never trained to be one. I'm just a shepherd, and I take care of sycamore-fig trees.

15 But the Lord called me away from my flock and told me, 'Go and prophesy to my people in Israel.'"

### **AMOS 1:1-2 NLT**

This message was given to Amos, a shepherd from the town of Tekoa in Judah. He received this message in visions two years before the earthquake, when Uzziah was king of Judah and Jeroboam II, the son of Jehoash, was king of Israel. 2 This is what he saw and heard: "The Lord's voice will roar from Zion and thunder from Jerusalem! The lush pastures of the shepherds will dry up; the grass on Mount Carmel will wither and die."





## **AMOS 2:4-8 NLT**

4 This is what the Lord says:

"The people of Judah have sinned again and again, and I will not let them go unpunished!

They have rejected the instruction of the Lord, refusing to obey his decrees.

They have been led astray by the same lies that deceived their ancestors.


5 So I will send down fire on Judah, and all the fortresses of Jerusalem will be destroyed."


### **AMOS 2:4-8 NLT**



#### **AMOS 4:4-5 NLT**

Offer sacrifices each morning, and bring your tithes every three days. 5 Present your bread made with yeast as an offering of thanksgiving. Then give your extra voluntary offerings so you can brag about it everywhere! This is the kind of thing you Israelites love to do," says the Sovereign Lord.

A "YES" TO OUR GOOD MEANS A NO TO WHAT BRINGS US HARM.


## AMOS 5:14-15 NLT




